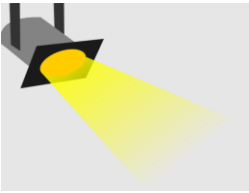

What Makes NextGen Unique:

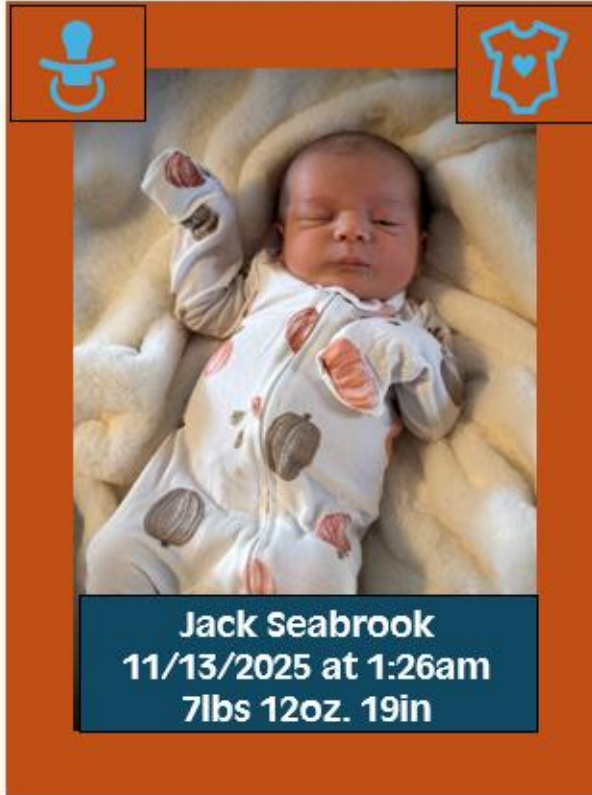
- A fully trained team with NICET certified designers and technicians supporting fire alarm, sprinkler, ERCES and low-voltage system design, installation and testing.

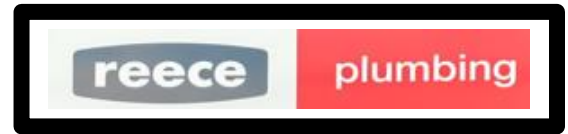
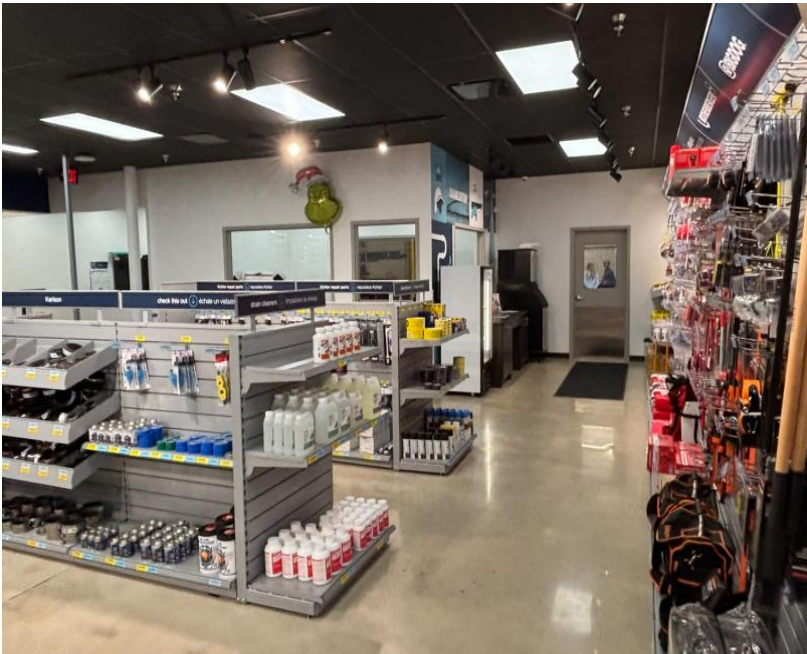
