Fall Protection Equipment Inspections (continued)



Daily Inspection

- User Inspection
 1. Webbing
 2. Metal components
 3. Stitching
 4. D-Rings
 5. Labels



**Should be performed daily by user and take 2-3 minutes



Points of Inspection

- Lanyards
 1. Snap Hooks
 2. Shock absorbers
 3. Adjustment parts
 4. Load Indicators
 5. Labels
