Proposed Bylaw Changes

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Change is something which happens to us everyday. It can be as simple as change that we carry in our pocket or it can be as dramatic as a life-changing event. But, for whatever reason, change is inevitable.

Due to circumstances beyond our control, several years ago our partner in the bid procedure, the CAGC, voted to discontinue the bid procedure. No matter what changes we tried, the bid procedure has not been used in over five years and with the bidding climate as it is today, it does not seem that it can be revitalized in the near future.

At my suggestion, the Board of Directors took on the task of looking at how our bylaws were setup and what changes we could make to reflect the current focus of our association, which is education, information, legislation, and workforce development.

Cautiously, and upon the advice of our legal counsel, Dan Brailsford, we made three major proposed changes to the bylaws and one to make voting on any future revisions easier.

1. The bid procedure would become a separate document referenced in the new bylaws.
2. The bylaws would be gender neutral, since more women are in the construction industry.
3. New language to protect the Board from individual liability for good faith actions.
4. A voting by proxy statement would be added.

Copies of the current bylaws and the proposed bylaws were emailed to all members on June 13, 2007. I encourage all members to review and respond to these changes and be prepared to vote on them at the called meeting. As voted by the Board, the called meeting will be held at our Summer Convention since a majority of our members participate at this event. This open business called meeting will take place on Sunday morning, July 22, 2007 at Callaway Gardens Resort, Pine Mountain, GA. As reflected in our current bylaws, a two-thirds affirmative vote of members in good standing present is required to pass a change. “Tool Box Talks” - Safety Tip
HEAT SURVIVAL

Hot day, hot job, high humidity and BINGO....another heat victim. No one is immune, and construction workers are prime candidates for heat related illnesses.

During hot weather stay alert for telltale symptoms and remember these first aid tips:

HEAT EXHAUSTION - Symptoms are heavy sweating, nausea, headache, weakness, vomiting, tiredness, fast pulse. First Aid - Move to a cooler area, cool by wetting towels and wiping down the forehead. Remove any wet or sweat soaked clothing. Fan the victim. Do not give any fluids to a victim unless fully conscious. Follow up with a medical checkup.

HEAT CRAMPS - Symptoms are severe muscle spasms in the back, stomach, arms and legs, usually caused by drinking large quantities of water without replacing salt during periods of heavy perspiration. First Aid - Move to a cooler area. Make sure that no water is given unless fully conscious. When you do give water make sure that the victim takes only slow small sips. Get medical attention as soon as possible.

HEAT STROKE - Symptoms are high temperature and dry skin, rapid breathing and pulse. Victims may appear disorganized and confused, with headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, seizures and the possibility of coma. First Aid - This is serious, so move fast to a cooler area and call an ambulance. Remove the outer clothing of the victim and apply cool water to the entire body. Fan the victim until professional medical help arrives.

To avoid heat illness, dress in cool clothing, wear your hard hat, don't over-exert your body during high temperature periods, and get plenty of fluids. Remember that heat related illnesses **MUST** have medical attention. If you are experiencing any of these heat related illnesses, going to the doctor will not effect your safety bonus, so go and get the medical attention you need. Heat illnesses should never be taken lightly.
